& passing the town of Burns to Grand St  
the third bridge on the North Fork of the  
Yuma River - then crossing on the line between  
the land of Justice & Andrew's to Heaton to the  
line between the lands of Joel & Heaton  
and Saml M. Heaton - then by the most  
direct and practicable route to the town  
of Ogayete. We think the location of the  
proposed road would be of general utility  
and therefore pray that your board take the  
necessary steps to have the same laid out
