Field notes & survey

By an order from the same County court of Yarnhill Co. of date March 4th 1868. the following persons met at the house of Ad. Hawthorn March 18th 1868 - T. R. Harrison Surveyor. Gal Thomas & John Perry viewers S. Umphlett and S. N. Pike Chairman - After being duly qualified proceeded to view and survey the said Alteration of county road of which the following is the field notes with plat of the same - Beginning at Post marked "R" in the road leading from Wayton to the Palk Co. line near Mr. Johnsons. said Post marked "R" is near the residence of Mrs Sarah Buffum. of which an oak ten 15 inches in diameter bears South 59° West 2.50 chains an oak tree 10 inches in dia. bears North 46° West 0.66 chs Thence South 15° West 20.50 chs to Angle Post No 1. with mound raised &c - Thence South 48° West 4.50 chs to Angle Post No 2 raised mound. Thence South 35° West 7.20 chs to Angle Post No 3 raised mound. &c = Thence South 72° West 6.06 chs to Angle No 4. to an oak tree 8 inches in dia. - Thence South 52° West 11.50 chs to Post marked R. when it intersects the said county road An oak tree 2. ft in dia bears South 43° East 0.80 chs. making the length of survey and alteration 49.76 chains
Length of old road $\frac{47.70}{2.06}$ difference
